

BASIC INFORMATION FOR PERFORMERS

PAYMENT

- Weekend day bands receive \$50, plus tips. Friday and Saturday evening acts set their own admission price, and receive 100% of the door. Weekday night performers can play for tips or set a price at the door. We ask that any acts wishing to charge at the door contact us in advance.
- Performers are entitled to half price on pitchers, and \$.50 discounts on drinks. These discounts apply to performers only. You are responsible for paying your tabs at the end of the performance.

PARKING/LOADING

- We have a small parking lot behind the venue for staff and performers, with a capacity of 7 vehicles at best. We cannot guarantee any specific number of spots will be available.
- Weekend day performers may load in any time after noon. Load out must be completed by 7:00pm. Evening performers may load in any time after 7:30pm. This allows our daytime staff to depart without shuffling cars and maximizes parking available for performers. Load out must be completed by 2:15am.
- **PLEASE NOTE- We DO NOT allow performer's vehicles to be left in our lot overnight.** If for any reason you are unable to move your vehicle, a member of our staff will move it to the nearest available spot for you. Failure to do so may result in your vehicle being towed at your expense.

PERFORMANCE

- Weekend afternoon performances begin at 3:00pm and end at 6:00pm. Evening performances begin at 9:30-10:00pm and may run as late as 1:45am. We have no requirements for set lengths or breaks.

EQUIPMENT

- We have a full PA system, microphones, cables, and stands available for all performers. Our wait staff is capable of operating all house equipment and can assist with sound checks and performances. Performers are welcome to bring their own sound tech, or we can provide one with advance notice. Performers requesting our sound man are responsible for negotiating his compensation.
- We do not provide any back line equipment.

MISC

- We ask that performers and their guests treat our staff respectfully- we're all in this together.
- There is a separate bathroom for staff and performers only, as well as a dressing room.
- There is a stairway on the left side of the stage that leads to the dressing room, staff bathroom, and kitchen. Please do not place amps, cases, etc. on or in front of the stairs, as staff will need access to them during the performance.
